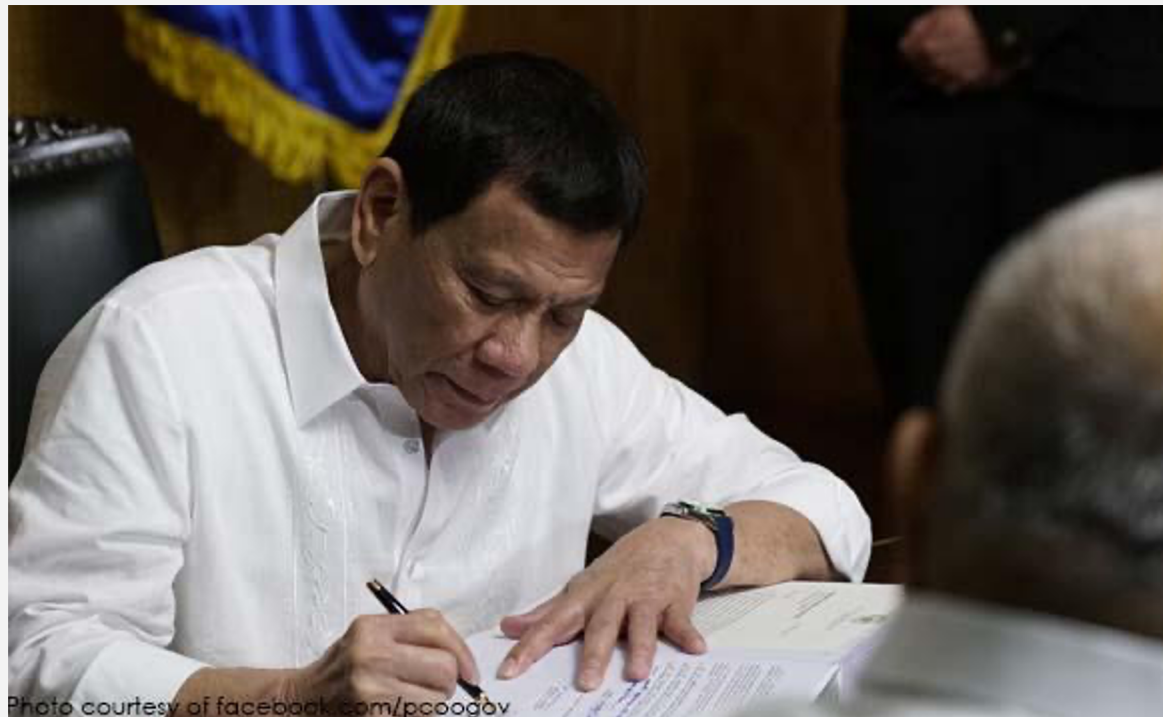


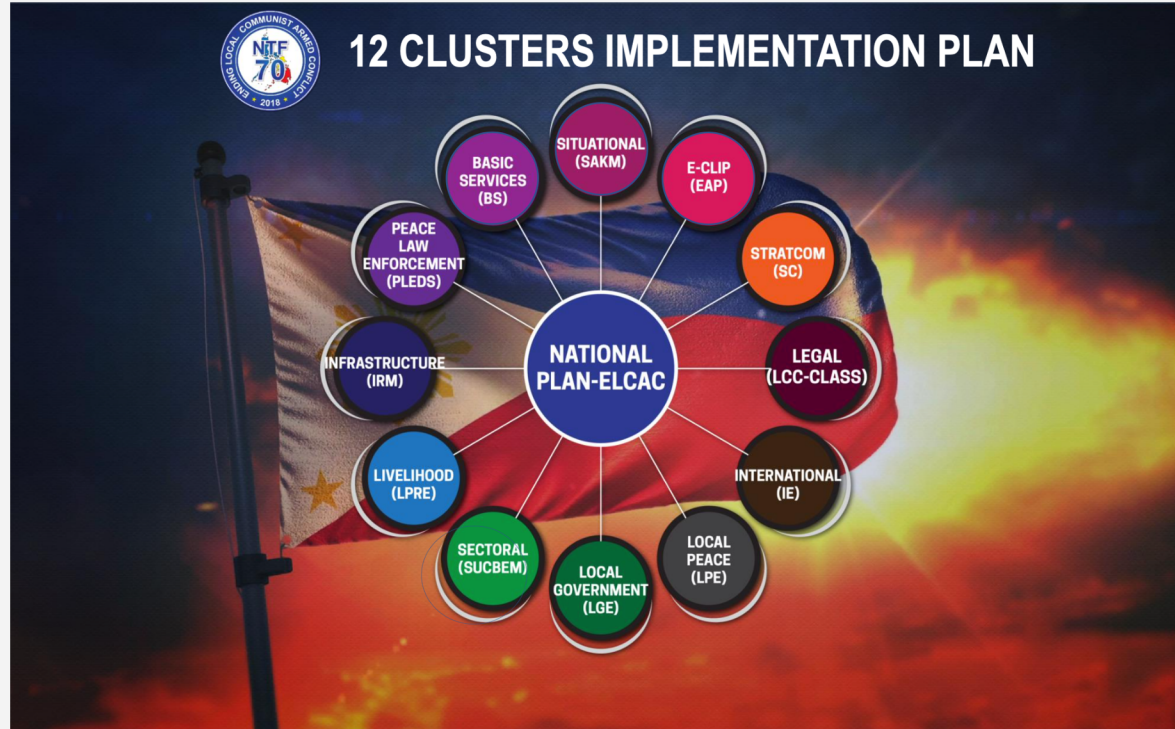

and/or members of the CTG )*

#### Local Level Peace Agreement

- May be conducted openly or discreetly; with or w/out intermediaries between govt. and local insurgent group
- Results to local peace agreement

#### E-CLIP Beneficiaries

- armed members who would like to avail of E-CLIP without the benefit of a local-level peace agreement

### Hermosa, Bataan

- Dialogue with 387 former members of Alyansang Magbubukid ng Gitnang Luzon



### Ilocos Sur

- Dialogue with 103 former UGMO members

- Reintegration to mainstream society of 26 NPA members and 20 Militia ng Bayan members.



## Peace Village in Talaingod, Davao del Norte

- 125 Ata-Manobo IP families from Haran reintegrated and provided shelter
- Healing and reconciliation activities





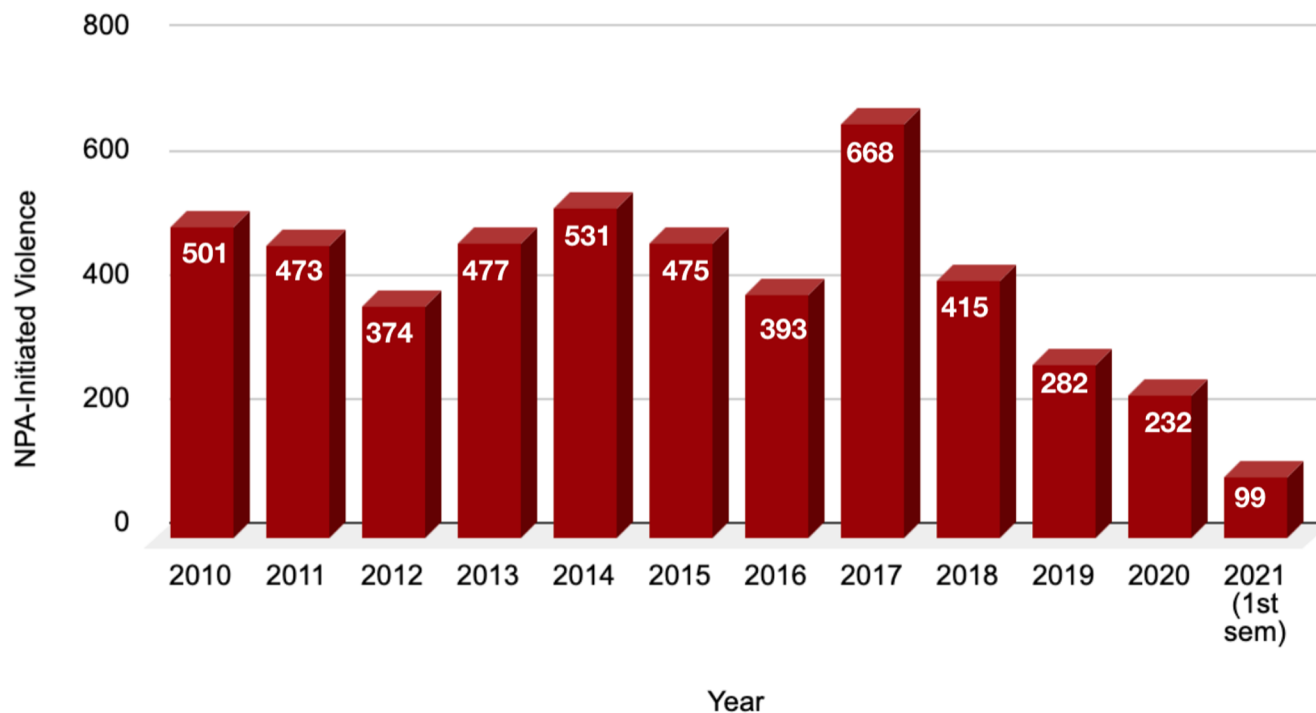
## CORDS 3 Accomplishments

- Decimated the CTGs KLG Caraballo and KLG Sierra Madre
- **137 LGUs** declared the CTG as persona-non grata
- **Withdrawal of support from CTG** by members of Gabriela, Kadamay, Farmers' Groups, other groups
- Implementation of KKDAT (Kabataan Kontra sa Droga at Terorismo) Program with **299,289 youth members**
- **166 FRs** provided with **P12,076,000.00** worth of financial assistance and **P20 million** fund assistance provided to Barangay San Mateo Sectoral partnership with farmers/irrigators and vulnerable groups
